



Bandskool instrument tuition: terms and conditions for students: October 2014+

- The standard hourly rate is £25 per hour for a 1-1 lesson.
- You must book for ten lessons in advance of beginning a given block.
- Payment is by cheque sent to our postal address or by online BACS transfer
- The first lesson is free in order to help you decide whether you wish to continue with a block of ten lessons. Payment can be made during that first meeting.
- Lesson dates, time and venue are flexible and arrived at by mutual consent between student and teacher. However, if the teacher must travel to your home for any given lesson, then there is a pro-rata additional charge for fuel depending on the mileage. This will be billed separately.
- However, within a given block of ten lessons, each lesson would normally be within a two week period; that is, at least one lesson every fortnight.
- Prior notice of at least 48 hours must be given if a pre-arranged date is to be reappointed or cancelled. Otherwise a cancellation fee equivalent to the cost of a given lesson will be imposed.
- The student will not be charged for teacher absence or teacher cancellation. Instead another date must be arrived at by mutual consent.
- Cost of lessons will be subject to a 20% discount (£20) if student signs up for a term of band coaching sessions (10 sessions) but will only happen during the period signed up.
- Mostly the lessons will be either on a weekday evening (4pm +) or weekend daytime; unless otherwise arranged.
- Please be punctual for your lesson.
- You will be expected to maintain an organised folder with notes and teaching materials.
- You will be expected to practice regularly as advised by the teacher.
- All refunds are at the discretion of bandskool.
