\* The number beside each diagram indicates the fret number where the chord begins.

\*\* Minor chords are usually indicated with a small letter followed by a small "m".

NOTE: # means to "sharp" or raise in pitch one fret. If a # follows the letter name of a chord, the chord should be played one fret higher than the regular position.

b means to "flat" or lower in pitch one fret. If a b follows the letter name of a chord, the chord position should be played one fret number lower than the regular position.
