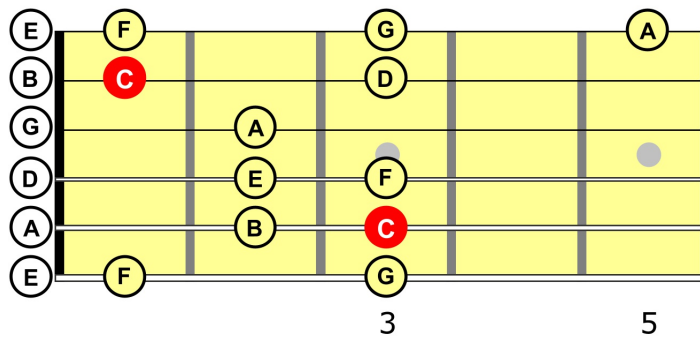
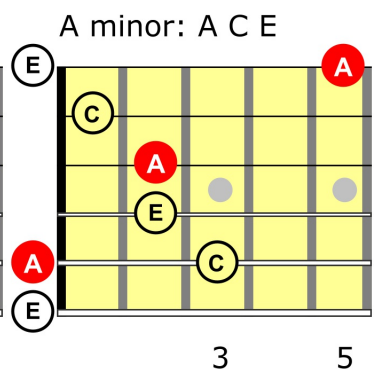
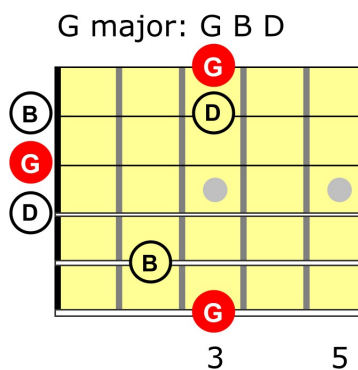
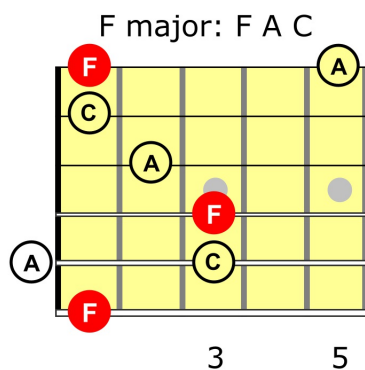
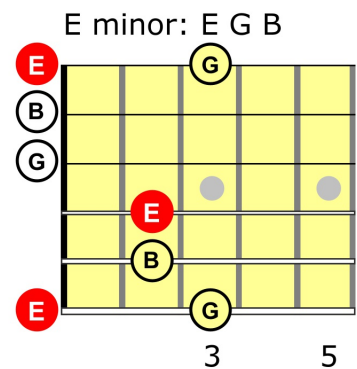
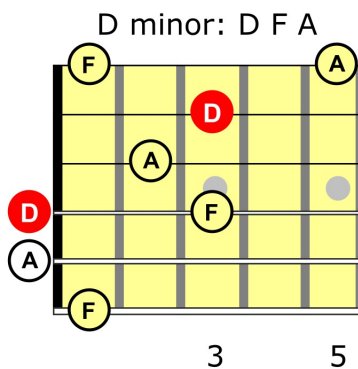
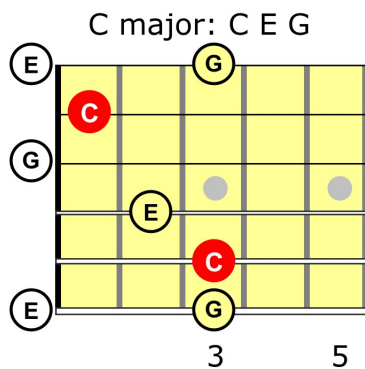


Diagram showing the C major scale on a guitar fretboard, including a musical staff and a tablature (TAB) line.
